All of the children have settled beautifully and are learning all of the new rules and routines. They are finding there way around the classroom and have all started to make new friends.

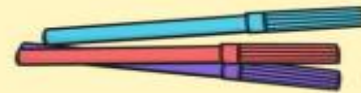
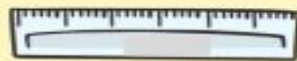


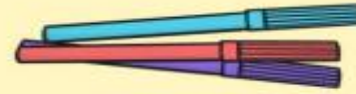
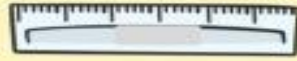
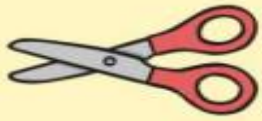


Entrance

Could we please ask that children do not bring toys into school from home.

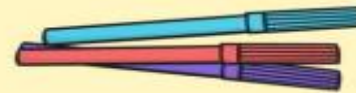
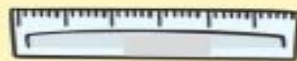


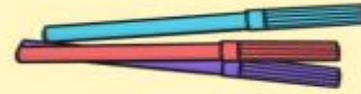
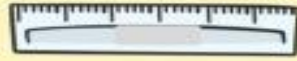
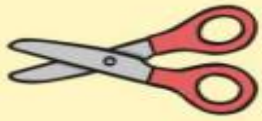


Exit

- Please do not call your child to you before the teacher safely hands them.

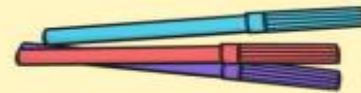
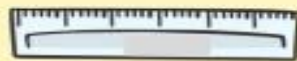


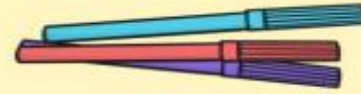
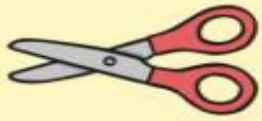


Toileting

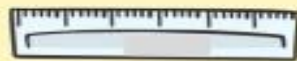


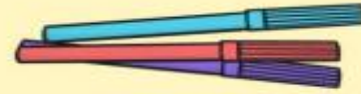
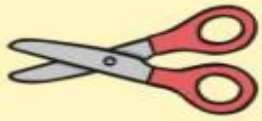


Lunch Time

The children will then go outside to play with the Mrs Wagner and Mrs French. If children aren't eating school lunch parents will always be informed.

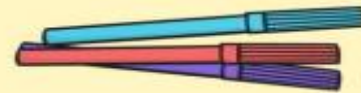
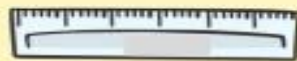


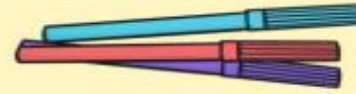
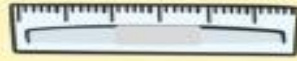
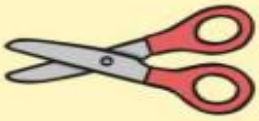

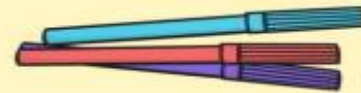
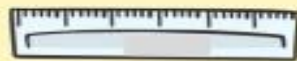


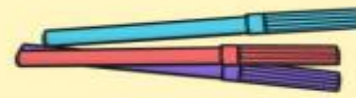
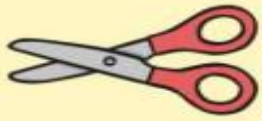


Reading in Reception

At OLSG we believe it is really important to develop a love of reading from an early age. Children learn to read through a range of opportunities:

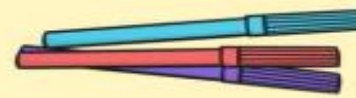
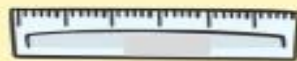
- Daily whole class shared reading

- Story time at the end of each day.

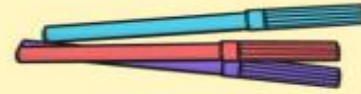
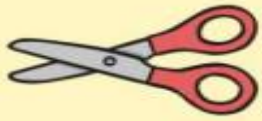




Home reading books

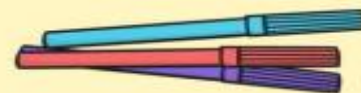
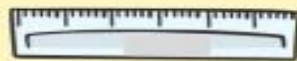
PE

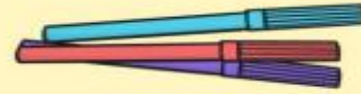
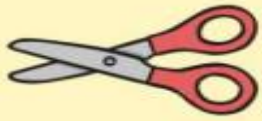
Children access Physical Development daily in a range of ways.
