Polite Reminders:

School Carpark: Please do not use the carpark to drop off and collect children or allow them to cross the carpark to use the carpark gate. Please use the pedestrian entrance. The carpark is for staff and visitors only. Dropping off or collecting your children from here is dangerous. There are cars reversing when children are walking across the carpark and it is not well lit. **Please keep our children safe.**

Smoking or Vaping: Smoking or vaping is not permitted in the school grounds. Please also be considerate when around the school gate areas when dropping off or collecting children.

Dogs: Please remember that dogs should not be brought onto school premises. If you do bring your dog to school please be mindful that dogs tied to the railing outside can obstruct the narrow pathway and should not be left unattended as they can become distressed. Please consider that not everyone is a dog person and some are allergic or fearful of dogs.

Parking: Please be considerate when parking to drop off / collect your child from school. Please do not park across or obstruct residents drive ways, even if it is only for a minute or two. Parking enforcement will be called. The school office regularly receives complaints from residents about parking. Please be considerate.

Mobile Phone Use: The use of mobile phones is not permitted in the school grounds. This is to safeguard children and parents.
